Her ability to work with others at home and regionally has brought millions of dollars in transportation improvements, synchronized signals, transit, trails, and improved traffic capacity.


She has championed work force housing leveraging grants into \$22 million of affordable housing because she knows that our economy is robust when people can live and work here.
